MEMORIAL MASS - HEBRIDEAN DISASTER ANNIVERSARY: FRIDAY MARCH 28TH, 9AM

Just before midnight on March 28th, 1940 a collision occurred between the British freighter Esmond and the Hebridean pilot boat based in Herring Cove. Nine crew members of the Hebridean perished that night, devastating the community of Herring Cove. After 85 years the memory of this disaster still resonates strongly. A memorial mass will take place at Stella Maris Parish in Spryfield at 9am on Friday March 28th.
